


Zeeland Record Digitization Project Update

• The University of Michigan Library is considering taking over this project. They anticipate letting us know their decision by mid-September. The scope of the project includes the re-digitization of the publication, 1893-2005 from microfilm and digitization of paper copies from 2006 to present. The final digitized content will be hosted by U-M Libraries in one of their digital collection databases and will be freely available to anyone for perpetuity if they accept our project. – Still waiting on their response as of 9/1/23.
