

Library Events/Programming Highlights

- The Building Block Cub continues to gain momentum with the weekly offering of this Monday evening program for kids in Kindergarten and older.
- Regular weekly Children's programming resumed on Wednesday's and Thursday's.
- Jessica Volkers began a new program series, the Building Block Club, for Lego enthusiasts on Monday evenings for kids in Kindergarten and up.
- Teens engaged in a craft program on Try It Tuesday and created paintings using acrylics.

Staff Highlights

- Jessica Volkers drafted the Summer Reading Program activity calendar for June through August (see attached listing).
- Amanda Hanson attended several meetings including 2 for the Lakeland Library Cooperative, Michigan Public Library Directors' Group and NEA Big Read group.
