


Staff Highlights

- On July 23rd Hope Velthouse was promoted from Librarian I to Librarian II and her duties include assuming print collection responsibilities for 3 fiction genres and managing the future development of the digital collection through the Overdrive online application
- Catherine Broadbooks was hired as a new Librarian I as of July 23rd
- AnnMarie Willette was hired as a Librarian I to replace Lindsey Sneller who is leaving as of August 17th – AnnMarie will start on August 19th
- Amanda Hanson was selected to participate in the 2024 Conversation Camp for Library Leaders
 Cohort. This conference will be held in Lansing, MI at the Library of Michigan on September 4-5.
 All course materials and presentation costs are covered by the Library of Michigan. The topics
 covered include Conversations Worth Having focusing on the Power of Conversation, the Art of
 Asking Questions, and Intentional Framing. Strategic Conversations will focus on Strategic
 Thinking and Mindset, SOAR Conversations, the Appreciative Inquiry 5-D Cycle, and Whole
 System Engagement Processes.

Zeeland Record Newspaper Digitization Project Update

• Digitization efforts are moving along as expected. We will not hear any more updates until they near completion of the project towards the end of 2024.

City of Zeeland 2024 Strategic Action Plan – Library Operational Goals Updates

- Progress working towards the operational goals for the Library to be completed within 2024 include:
 - 1. Increase community partnerships and collaborations
 - a. Amanda H. participated in the first session of the Zeeland Citizen's Academy on July 10th. 13 citizens and other City staff listened to a presentation highlighting the administration of the Howard Miller Library & Community Center and then toured the building.
 - 2. Refresh/update library space to encourage usage and enhance comfort for patrons
 - a. New tables, chairs and side tables were ordered and delivered to increase seating and working areas for patrons upstairs in the library.
 - b. 4 new computers ordered for the Children's area to host the online subscription to Magic Desktop which provides games and tools for children under 12.
 - 3. Optimize training opportunities for all staff including part-time employees
 - a. 2 full-time staff participated in a professional development training course in July covering Digital Safety and Privacy in the Library.
