

Library Events/Programming Highlights

City of Zeeland 2024 Strategic Action Plan – Library Operational Goals Updates

- Progress working towards the operational goals for the Library to be completed within 2024 include:
 - 1. Increase community partnerships and collaborations
 - a. After the voter approval of the library millage proposal in Olive Township, the contract for library services between Olive Township and the City of Zeeland through the Howard Miller Library was reinstated for a 4-year term through November 30, 2028.
 - b. Negotiations with Zeeland Charter Township representatives and City of Zeeland representatives resulted in a revised contract for library services between the Zeeland Charter Township and the City of Zeeland through the Howard Miller

Library. This contract was approved will be in effect January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2027.

3. Optimize training opportunities for all staff including part-time employees

- a. 6 on demand webinars were viewed by 5 staff members.
- b. 1 staff member attended the Youth Literature Seminar in Kalamazoo on 11/1.
- c. 3 staff members attended the live CPR training offered by Chief Tibbots of the Zeeland Fire Department.
