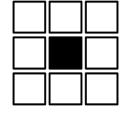
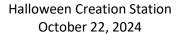

## **Library Events/Programming Highlights**

- The Lakeshore Author Meet and Greet event on October 3<sup>rd</sup> was a success with a dozen authors participating and over 100 patrons visiting. We plan to offer this bi-annually.
- A new program for Tweens this Fall, Doodles and Donuts, was a success with 19 participants.
- Staff Development Day was held on Monday, October 14<sup>th</sup> and Robyn Schopp led our team through the 6 Types of Working Genius concepts. 15 staff members were able to attend this day of training.
- We hosted 106 attendees at the Halloween craft program on October 22<sup>nd</sup>.
