Meeting called to order 4:32pm.

Minutes from the September 17th, 2024 meeting were approved as written. M-MaryBeth Timmer, S-Mary Wilkos - Passed unanimously.

Staff Introduction: AnnMarie Willette, Librarian I, was introduced to the Board. She was hired in August and is a retired Middle and High School teacher from Saugutuck, MI. She likes mysteries and crime books.

Director's Report:

- A. Fall 2024 programming is in full swing additional sessions of the Toddle Laptime and Preschool sessions have been added to accommodate larger crowds.
- B. Staffing updates: we will be fully staffed after our 2 newest Librarian I hires start: Carol Talsma begins October 21st and Megan Hoeksema begins November 12th.
