


## Request for Reconsideration of Library Materials Procedures and Form

- Those requesting the reconsideration of any library materials in the collection must have <u>read</u>, <u>heard or viewed the work in its entirety</u> to have the challenge considered.
- 2. The library director along with those staff members involved in collection development will review the request and then the item in question. The requestor's concern, Howard Miller Library materials selection policy, and professional reviews will be used in the review process. This process shall take place within 30 days.
- 3. Howard Miller Library responds to requests for reconsideration of library materials from residents of the library's service area in writing at the time of the form submission and then afterwards with the decision of those executing the review.
- 4. The library director will report the initial request for reconsideration along with the findings of the staff involved in the review process to the Howard Miller Library Board.
- 5. The complainant retains the right to appeal the decision if he/she/they believe the reconsideration of materials policy was not followed by the library director and staff conducting the review. The Howard Miller Library Board may then review the process used in the review of the materials in question and will report their findings to the complainant.
